- The same birds may land more than once. To avoid counting them twice, please submit the highest number you see of each bird species at any one time in the hour - not the total number you count over the hour.
- 4 Tell us what you've seen in your hour, even if you saw nothing - it's still really useful information! Tell us about other wildlife that visits your garden or local park during the year too.
- 5 Submitting your results online is quick, easy and saves on postage, so we can spend more on conservation. Please visit: rspb.org.uk/birdwatch using code BH10 Alternatively, fill in and return this form to us.
